

The Federal Lands Highway Program in Florida. Located along Florida's east central coast, Merritt Island National Wildlife Refuge overlays the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's John F. Kennedy Space Center. The refuge consists of over 140,000 acres of mixed coastal habitats and supports over 500 wildlife species and over 1,000 plant species.

Shiloh Marsh Road, an 11.6-mile road atop a dike within the refuge, was being rehabilitated by Eastern Federal Lands when

Hurricane Charley caused extensive damage. The storm surge caused the water level to rise more than 5 feet, washing away whole sections of the dike and much of the new road material. With the use of funds from the Emergency Relief for Federally Owned Roads program, the road was repaired and reopened after an extended 2 ½ year closure. The project also included the rehabilitation of Cruickshank Trail (0.3 miles) and the rehabilitation of Bairs Cove Parking Area.
