

The Federal Lands Highway Program in New Hampshire. Kancamagus National Scenic Byway, from the Pemigewasset River at Lincoln to the Saco River at Conway, passes through the heart of the White Mountain National Forest in New Hampshire. The "Kanc" is also part of the White Mountains Trail National Scenic Byway. These byways are famous for their natural splendor, cultural richness, historic charm, and stimulating recreation opportunities. The New Hampshire Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the USDA Forest Service and Eastern Federal Lands, reconstructed the byway under the Forest Highway Program in conjunction with other sources of transportation funding, to restore it and to enhance the natural beauty and cultural heritage of northern New England.
