

2014 Alaska FLAP Call for Projects June 26, 2014

The Programming Decision Committee (PDC) responsible for the Alaska Federal Lands Access Program has selected its short-list of projects. The next step in the project review process will include development of match agreements by Western Federal Lands (WFL) Highway Division and the State/Local Agency partners.
