 - Funds can be used for pedestrian access improvements, or utility relocation on access roads. Focus on Step 2 of the SOP to establish project rating criteria and values.
 - Initial call for projects will be for FY13-FY14. The program of projects may be extended to more than 2 years contingent on number and quality of applications. Any future call for projects to be determined after initial call is evaluated.
 - PDC may establish funding limits or caps after application rating and ranking.
 - PDC to establish criteria and rating values.
 - Program Project Approval: completed

 - Project Proposal Application: posted on the website
