

# Subpart G—Maintenance

- ▶ GENERAL – Removes BIA Road Maintenance Program and focuses strictly on the maintenance activities and functions allowed under TTP.
  - § 170.800
    - Identifies funding available for maintenance per MAP-21
  - § 170.801
    - Clarifies that funds designated for maintenance cannot be used for improvements.
  - § 170.802
    - Verifies that Tribes can carry out maintenance activities
  - § 170.803
    - Identifies to what standards TTP facilities must be maintained, subject to funding availability.

# Subpart G – (continued)

- § 170.804
  - Describes actions that can be taken if maintenance funding is deemed inadequate.
- § 170.805
  - Identifies the BIA and FHWA websites where tribes can find the list of eligible maintenance activities.

# Subpart H – Miscellaneous Provisions

GENERAL – All material previously included in this Subpart for reference only has been removed including:

- Hazardous and Nuclear Waste Transportation; and
- Emergency Relief

## ▶ *Reporting Requirements and Indian Preference*

- § 170.910
  - Describes how BIA and FHWA must provide information to tribes after receiving a written request
- § 170.911 – 917
  - Provide information on Indian Preference and Employment. No significant changes were made to these sections other than to update so as to represent current statutory and program references.
- § 170.918
  - Describes the Secretaries' collection of data on the TTP.

# Subpart H – (continued)

## ▶ *Tribal Transportation Departments*

- § 170.930 – 933

- No significant changes were made to these sections other than to update references to reflect the current program or statutes.

## ▶ *Resolving Disputes*

- § 170.934 – 935

- Outlines the alternative dispute resolution procedures that are available. No major changes other than the section was updated to include FHWA Program Agreements.

## ▶ *Other Miscellaneous Provisions*

- § 170.941 – 942

- Discusses transportation research and quality of life programs. No significant changes made other than updates.

- § 170.943

- Describes that the Tribal High Priority Projects Program is not part of the TTP and that information can be found on the BIA and FHWA websites.
