Snug Harbor Road: Mile Post 0.0 to Mile Post 1.8

Construction work will begin shortly on the Snug Harbor Road Paving and Bike Trail project.

The tree clearing limits have been staked with blue and green flagging and are in the process of being reviewed. Clearing will only be conducted within the State's Right of Way or on Temporary Construction Easements.

The clearing work is anticipated to begin on Monday, March 28th and continue throughout the last week of March. Property owners who have questions about the project or the clearing work are encouraged to contact the Project Engineer, Matt Bean. Matt will gladly meet with individuals to review the clearing and explain the upcoming work.

During clearing work any wood suitable for firewood will be saved and will become the property of the adjacent land owner. Any wood harvested from the Kenia Peninsula Borough or Alaska Department of Natural Resources property will be available to the general public.

Expect to see construction equipment beginning to mobilize to the project within the next few weeks.

In conjunction with this project there will be work for a utility relocation project along the roadway administered by the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities. Contact Marcus Forkner at 907-269-0450 for questions regarding the utility relocation work.
