Snug Harbor Road: Mile Post 0.0 to Mile Post 1.8

The tree clearing work has been pushed back and will now begin the week of April 4th. Work on Monday, April 4th is expected to be equipment mobilizing to the project and final preparations for the clearing work. Clearing work will likely fully begin on Tuesday, April 5th.

The tree clearing limits have been staked with blue and green flagging and are in the process of being reviewed. Clearing will only be conducted within the State's Right of Way or on Temporary Construction Easements.

Property owners who have questions about the project or the clearing work are encouraged to contact the Project Engineer, Matt Bean.

During clearing work any wood suitable for firewood will be saved and will become the property of the adjacent land owner. Any wood harvested from the Kenia Peninsula Borough or Alaska Department of Natural Resources property will be available to the general public.

Expect to see construction traffic increasing and equipment mobilizing to the project within the next few weeks.
