Snug Harbor Road: Mile Post 0.0 to Mile Post 1.8

The tree clearing work for the project is underway. Carlos Tree Service spent the past week clearing the smaller trees and shrubs in the separated bike path and shoulder widening segments of the project. The larger trees will be cut and decked as clearing continues this next week.

During clearing work wood suitable for firewood is being saved and will become the property of the adjacent land owner. Any wood harvested from the Kenia Peninsula Borough or Alaska Department of Natural Resources property will be available to the general public. Some firewood has already been cut. Please be sure not to take wood belonging to a private property owner.

The clearing work will be ongoing throughout this week and the work schedule is Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
