Snug Harbor Road: Mile Post 0.0 to Mile Post 1.8

The tree clearing work for the project continues. Carlos Tree Service spent the past week clearing and has completed clearing work for the separated bike path and the shoulder widening segments of the project.

Clearing work will continue into next week as the crews continue up the road clearing the roadway reconstruction segment of the project.

Wood suitable for firewood continues to be saved and left along the side of the roadway throughout the project. Any wood harvested from the Kenia Peninsula Borough or Alaska Department of Natural Resources property is available to the general public. The public is encouraged to gather the firewood in the evenings, over the weekends, or at times when no work is being conducted in the immediate area.
