Snug Harbor Road: Mile Post 0.0 to Mile Post 1.8

Utility work is ongoing throughout the project. This past week Sturgeon's telecommunications crew continues to plow in new Telalaska phone lines up to the beginning of the roadway reconstruction section of the project. Telalaska completed switching over service lines to the newly installed utility pedestals along the separated bike path section of the project. This upcoming week both Sturgeon's telecommunications crew and electrical crew will be working onsite continuing with utility relocation work.

Ancor, Inc. began preparations for producing select borrow material in the Dave's Creek Pit. Ancor will begin full production this next week.

There is still a large pile of firewood located in the gravel area near the senior housing driveway. This wood is available for anyone in the public to take.

Construction operations can be expected from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
