## CURRENT AND UPCOMING WORK

The contractor is currently installing two Aquatic Organism Passage culverts on the lower end of the road. The Road is closed through September 26, 2016 to facilitate this work, and the contractor will be working the weekend in the closure zone to complete the work. In addition the contractor has neared completion of the Thorn Creek crossing. All traffic is now being routed over the new alignment.

## GOOSE LAKE ROAD TRAFFIC DELAYS AND CLOSURES

The contractor is working from 7:00am to 6:30pm Monday thru Friday.

Road Closures are in place 7:00am to 6:30pm, with the following exceptions.

- 30 minute delays from 7:00 am to 8:00 am, with piloted traffic.
- Road openings are provided at 10 am, 12 pm, and 2:30 pm for 30 minute periods.
- 30 minute delays from 5 pm to 6:30 pm, with piloted traffic.

### Road Closure on Goose Lake Road continue through September 26th

A 1 mile section of Goose Lake Road will be closed between SH-55 and Bear Basin Road beginning on Monday, September 19th and ending on Monday, September 26th. During this time a Detour Route will be provided along Old Brundage Mountain Road and Bear Basin Road. The Detour is approximately 5 miles in length, along a gravel road and will take approximately 20 minutes to pass through. Please exercise caution while navigating the detour. Be aware that some locations along the detour are wide enough for only a single vehicle.
