





Notice:

Mobilization of materials and equipment to the site is underway. Debco Const. has delivered and setup a field office at the Burley Trap Club, adjacent to the site (photo below).



Traffic Control:

From 6:00 a.m. Monday to 4:00 p.m. Friday half of Milner Loop Road including the associated approach roads is closed to public traffic. Trout Point Road will be used as the closure point. Work performed on the open portion of the road will be completed with less than 15 minute delays.



Clearing and Grubbing Operations

Construction survey operations are underway and after a section has been staked the BLM is conducting an archeological survey of the area. Once the section is cleared, clearing and grubbing operations are being performed.

Work has also started on the two realignment sections of the project. The first will create a new intersection with Trout Point Road at station 67.95 to improve the sight distance and a second to allow safer passage of larger vehicles through the railroad trestle at station 134+50.

Materials Processing

Debco has located an ITD materials source south of Burley, ID on Hwy. 27 and are setting up to start processing borrow and aggregate material to be incorporated into the work.
