RIMINI ROAD NEWSLETTER

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Project Description

Rimini Road is located 10 miles west of Helena, MT off of Highway 12. The project begins at the intersection with Highway 12 and extends 6.25 miles south to the intersection with Chessman Reservoir Road. Project improvements include reconstructing three bridges, asphalt paving, guardrail updates, and realignment of 2,000 ft of Ten Mile Creek away from the roadway. Lewis and Clark County will assume maintenance duties upon completion of the project.



Road Surface conditions

The current road surface is existing compacted gravel with minor pot holes.



Current and Upcoming Work

The contractor, Debco Construction, will complete clearing operations by the end of May. Roadway excavation will begin shortly after clearing is complete. Material source development at MP 0.7 and crushing operations are anticipated around mid-June. Bridge construction operations consist of pile drilling at bridge #2, followed by bridge #1 and bridge #3.



Traffic Delays

Expect 30 minute delays, Monday through Friday, 7am to 6pm. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers and pilot car. There may be laborers working on the road shoulder, please drive safe and be courteous. Please follow the newsletter for future updates.
