



## **WOODLAWN CULTURAL LANDSCAPE HISTORIC DISTRICT**

SPREAD OVER 140 ROLLING ACRES, THIS HISTORIC DISTRICT CONTAINS OVER 200 YEARS OF HISTORY, WITH SIGNIFICANT BUILDINGS RANGING FROM THE ANTEBELLUM WOODLAWN MANSION TO ARCHITECT FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT'S POPE-LEIGHEY HOUSE. ORIGINALLY PART OF GEORGE WASHINGTON'S ESTATE, THE WOODLAWN ACREAGE WAS PURCHASED BY QUAKERS WHO SOLD TRACTS TO LIKE-MINDED FARMERS, INCLUDING FREEDMEN. WOODLAWN QUAKER MEETINGHOUSE AND BURIAL GROUND AND GRAND VIEW ARE REMNANTS OF THIS PAST. OTHER NOTABLE RESOURCES INCLUDE: OTIS TUFTON MASON HOUSE, WOODLAWN BAPTIST CHURCH CEMETERY, GEORGE WASHINGTON'S GRISTMILL, AND SHARPE STABLE COMPLEX. THREATENED BY DEMOLITION, THE POPE-LEIGHEY HOUSE WAS MOVED HERE IN 1964.
