Eastern Federal Lands Highway Division of the FHWA, in cooperation with Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), the U.S. Department of Defense, Stafford County, and Shirley Contracting Company/Dewberry Consultants are holding a Location and Design Public Hearing for the Telegraph Road and U.S. Route 1 Intersection Improvements project. The purpose of this Defense Access Roads (DAR) funded project is to improve both traffic safety and operations which are necessary to handle the increase in vehicular traffic in the area that is associated with the Marine Corps Base Quantico (MCBQ). This project will provide turn lane improvements necessary for critical ingress/egress to Department of Defense (DoD) facilities on MCBQ and is scheduled to be completed in the fall of 2014.

The public hearing will be conducted in an Open Forum format. Project information displayed for public review will include the project plans, property impacts, right of way policies, the Categorical Exclusion, and tentative construction schedules. Informational displays and handouts will be available at the meeting and project staff will be on hand to answer questions. A Categorical Exclusion (CE) document addressing the projects impacts was prepared for this project in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act and FHWA's Environmental Impact and Related Procedures (23 CFR 771) and will be available for review. The CE is also posted on FHWA's website, <http://www.efl.fhwa.dot.gov/projects/telegraph.aspx>. In compliance with the National Historic Preservation Act, Section 106 and 36 CFR Part 800, information concerning the potential effects of the proposed improvements on properties listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places will also be available at the hearing.
