CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

The road is 'getting into shape' as the biggest cut near the top of Mt. Finlayson is completed and all that material has been moved down the slope to build up the road near the DNR Vista. It is looking like a road!

Next week excavation & embankment continues along with the finished slopes being stabilized with a wood mulch/tackifier mix to hold the slopes until seeding in September.
