Improvements Begin on the Cispus Road

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

This week marks the beginning of construction activities. The contractor has begun operations between mileposts 5.0 and 9.5, including; asphalt milling, patch work and culvert replacements. Next weeks anticipated plans are to continue with the culvert replacements in this road section. Watch for flaggers, construction equipment and patches of loose gravel on the roadway and prepare for the possibility of short delays.
