Improvements Continue on the Cispus Road

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

This week the contractor is continuing operations below Milepost 5, which includes grinding, pavement patching and culvert replacement. **NEXT WEEK THE CISPUS ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC BETWEEN MILEPOST MP 2.71 AND MP 5.27 FROM 10:00AM JULY 25 THRU 4:00PM JULY 28, 2016.** In this time the contractor will replace two culverts that are positioned over 20 feet below the current road surface. Watch for flaggers, construction equipment and patches of loose gravel on the roadway and prepare for the possibility of short delays.
