

Improvements Continue on the Cispus Road

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

The Cispus Road is open to all traffic. This week the contractor replaced the two culverts that are positioned over 20 feet below the road surface and several other culverts during the road closure. Next week the contractor will finish with the culvert replacement and asphalt patching will again be taking place. Thanks to all for the patience and understanding during the week long closure. Watch for flaggers, construction equipment and patches of loose gravel on the roadway and prepare for the possibility of short delays.
