NISQUALLY TO PARADISE ROAD NEWSLETTER

June 9, 2016

Project Description

The Nisqually to Paradise Road project spans 11 miles from Longmire to the Paradise Inn Parking lot and Jackson Memorial Visitor center. Project improvements include cleaning and replacing drainage culverts, pavement subgrade, parking areas, and patching. National Park service will assume maintenance duties upon completion of the project.



Road Surface conditions

Current road condition is existing asphalt roadway with transitions to a ground up asphalt surface.



Current and Upcoming Work

The contractor, Tucci and Sons, has begun installing erosion control devices and mobilizing equipment and supplies. Culvert cleaning and pavement milling operations are expected to start in the third week of June.



Traffic Delays

Expect a 30 minute traffic delay. Drive slow around blind corners and be cautious of workers on the roadway.
