#### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Lakeside Industries continued patching Sol Duc Road this week and after reaching the end of the road—turned around and are marching down the northbound lane. There will be about 7 miles remaining to be done next week.

Next week, Sol Duc Road will be completed and patching will take place in the Sol Duc Parking Lots as well as Loops A and B.
