FULL ROAD CLOSURE IN EFFECT, INCLUDING WEEKENDS

Middle Fork Road is closed between the CCC trailhead and Taylor River Bridge through September 26. Visitors who wish to travel beyond the road closure may do so via the CCC Trail. However, please note that there is no motorized access beyond the CCC Trailhead. Limited parking is available at the road closure point. When parking please do not block access to the closed area for Contractor or emergency vehicles. Any vehicles parking at the closure on the weekend must leave the project area by noon on Monday.

Planned project work this week includes placing roadway fill and surfacing rock, working on the two new bridges, and rock blasting. Paving the upper portion of the project will begin this week. A night shift will be installing culvert pipes.

The Middle Fork Snoqualmie River Road will continue to be closed Mondays at noon through Fridays at noon through Friday October 31, 2014 at Valley Camp. Expect delays of up to 60 minutes Monday morning, 6:00AM to Noon and Friday from noon to 4:00 PM. During these open times, traffic will be routed to and from the closure at the CCC trail by a pilot car.

Eastern Intersection of Lake Dorothy Road (Upper Couplet) to Middle Fork Campground

Road Closed*: 12:00pm (noon) Monday — 12:00pm (noon) Friday

* Except Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day weekends

Road Open*: 12:00pm (noon) Friday — 12:00pm (noon) Monday

* Up to 60 minute Delays Allowed
