MIDDLE FORK ROAD REPAIRS CONTINUE

The contractor has repaired two of the three slide areas within the roadway and has started work on the third. Design of the washed out roadway repair is complete and the contractor will start work on this as soon as the third slide area is stabilized for heavy construction equipment to cross.

The road is currently closed to vehicle traffic at the Mailbox Peak Trailhead. On Wednesday May 6, the roadway closure will move to Valley Camp. Starting May 6th the road will be closed to all traffic, including pedestrians and bicycles, at Valley Camp Mondays at noon to Fridays at noon.

Between Fridays at noon and Mondays at noon the vehicular closure will be at Mailbox Peak trailhead. The road will be open to bicycles and pedestrians beyond that point.

ROAD CLOSURES & DELAYS

Middle Fork Snoqualmie River Road is closed to vehicle traffic at Mailbox Peak trailhead.

Starting Wednesday May 6th, the road will be closed to all traffic, including pedestrians and bicycles, from noon Mondays through noon Fridays.

From noon Fridays through noon Mondays the road will be closed at the Mailbox Peak trailhead to motor vehicles. The road beyond that point will be open to pedestrians and bicyclists.

The road will reopen to all traffic between noon Fridays and noon Mondays when roadway repairs have been completed. The date of this opening date will be published in a future newsletter.
