MIDDLE FORK ROAD REPAIRS CONTINUE

The contractor has repaired two of the three slide areas within the roadway and is working on the third. It is anticipated that repair of the washed out roadway section will begin this week or next.

The road will be closed to all traffic, including pedestrians and bicycles, at Valley Camp Monday May 11th at 7:00 AM through Friday May 14 at 3:30 PM. Friday May 14 at 3:30 PM the closure will move to the Mailbox Peak Trailhead. The road beyond the trailhead will be open to bicycles and pedestrians through the weekend.

ROAD CLOSURES & DELAYS

The road is closed at Valley Camp to vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles from 7:00 AM Monday May 11 through 3:30 PM Friday May 14.

The road will be closed to vehicles at the Mailbox Peak Trailhead Friday May 14 at 3:30 PM through Monday May 18 at 7:00 AM. The road beyond Mailbox Peak will be open to pedestrians and bicycles during this time.
