### MIDDLE FORK SNOQUALMIE RIVER ROAD CLOSED

The weather event on November 17, 2015 caused impacts to the Middle Fork Snoqualmie River Road. The storm caused flooding that over topped the roadway in places as well as brought down trees throughout the project area. Cleanup operations are under way by the contractor to clear the roadway of down trees and debris. Due to current conditions on the project the roadway will remain closed above Mailbox Peak over the weekend in into start of next week.
