CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

This project will reconstruct 400 feet of the Middle Fork Road approximately one mile above the end of the couplet. The project will construct an 18 to 20-foot paved roadway with guard-rail, striping, and signing. The project will install draped, pinned, rockfall protection mesh on the cut slope needed to widen the roadway. This project will also install riprap under the Lake Dorothy bridge.

The contractor is scheduled to start moving equipment on to the project site and surveying next week.
