CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

The tree falling is done and Bruch & Bruch worked on moving embankment material from the tunnel entrance and placing as embankment along the trail this week.

There were several discussions regarding the stability of the slopes near the North entrance to the tunnel. FHWA's Geotechnical Engineers are designing a plan which will make the area safe for workers and the public.
